# WATER SAMPLE TESTING FORM

## TEST DESCRIPTION AND BREAKDOWN

Your choice of water testing may select to test the levels of specific metals and organics. These options are listed below with pricing explanations.

1. **Inorganic Chemistry** - Tests for the following metals: aluminum, arsenic, cadmium, chromium (total), copper, iron, lead, mercury, nickel, manganese, and zinc.

\$10 per metal *except mercury which is \$20* for a total of \$120.

2. **Volatile Organic Compounds (EPA 524.2)** - Tests for volatile organics: TCE, PCE, 1,2-DCE, cis1,2-DCE, and TTHM.

\$65.00 total.

3. **Hexavalent Chromium** - Tests hexavalent chromium (Cr6) only.

\$25.00 total.

4. **Total Chromium** - Tests only the total amount of all chromium.

\$10.00 total.

5. **Lead/Copper** - Test can be requested for either metal individually or both together.

\$10.00 per metal for a total up to \$20.

6. **General Mineral** - Testing includes bicarbonate, carbonate, alkalinity, calcium, chloride, copper, fluoride, magnesium, sodium, sulfate, and total hardness.

\$90.00 total.
